#### Xian, China

A private half day tour to see the Terracotta Warriors - a sight not to be missed when staying in Xian!

#### ■ The Tour

On this tour you will first see the 6,000 terracotta figures of warriors and horses that were buried underground for more than 2000 years. The site is now the famous terra-cotta Museum, which consists of three main buildings, Pit 1, Pit 2 and Pit 3. The three pits occupy an area of 2,000 square meters, housing about 8,000 life-size pottery warriors and horses. These are acclaimed as the 'Eighth Wonder of the World' and no visit to Xi'an is complete without seeing this amazing sight.

Transportation by private vehicle, visit and guided tour of Terracotta Warrior figures.

Before the day is out, you have the chance to admire the elegance of Wu Gorge and the huge expanse of Xiling Gorge.

**Day 4:** Overnight, your vessel passes through the ship locks at the immense Three Gorges Dam, built as the largest hydroelectric plant in the world. Step ashore for an up-close look at this monumental engineering project, before leaving Xiling Gorge behind for the final journey to Yichang. A transfer can take you to the local airport for your departing flight, or to your hotel if you plan to stay and explore the sights some more.

#### ■ The Tour

The first stop on this tour is the Yu Yuan Garden, a classic creation of the Ming Dynasty, and Shanghai Old street, that originated in the Qing Dynasty. Then, the tour stops at the Bund, Shanghai's waterfront, well known as the international Architecture Exhibition. Here you'll enjoy the wonderful view of both sides of the Huangpu River. Followed with a visit to the Shanghai Museum of Ancient Chinese Art (closed on every Monday) or Shikumen Wulixiang Museum, you'll enjoy a collection of more than 120,000 precious and rare works in 21 categories. It is regarded as the most remarkable cultural institution in the city. After lunch, drive along the former French Concession and transfer to visit Shanghai Arts and Crafts Store. Then visit the Jade Buddha Temple with its priceless jade statues from Burma. The last stop, Xin Tian Di, is a stylish nightlife district with many boutiques, pubs and restaurants. You will have time on your own there, or could go back to the original hotel where you are picked up.
