

Secrets of France Itinerary

16 Days - Departing 24th April - 9th May 2026

Day 1 – Friday, 24th April 2026 – Arrive Paris: Bonjour! Welcome to Paris – the City of Lights. Your trip kicks off with a welcome meeting with your Tour Leader at 6:00 PM tonight at your hotel. Ride the Bastille Cable Car up to Fort de la Bastille, perched on a hilltop, offering spectacular views of the surrounding mountains and city below. Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant featuring regional cuisine before returning to Chambéry in the afternoon.

Your tour concludes at the Château des Ducs de Savoie, where you'll enjoy a self- guided visit. To end your day, savour a wine tasting hosted by your Tour Leader at a local wine shop, sampling some of the region's best vintages.



Day 9 - Saturday 2nd May 2026 - Chambéry / Annecy: Travel by train to Annecy, often called the "Venice of the Alps." Visit the historic Château d'Annecy and board a local bus to Col de la Forclaz for amazing views while enjoying a snack and coffee. Go for a walk along the lake, and enjoy some free time to continue exploring on your own. Explore the Old Town and its canals in Little Venice. Return to Chambéry in the evening.
